- Treasury Update: Total funds available right now - \$20,843.00, incoming soon an additional \$2,400 from Sams Club, Summit County and another donor for a grand total of \$23,243.00!!!!
- Insurance update - saving money on insurance this year, saving over \$1,200 dollars by switching to a different company
- Monday morning check-in conversation continues....
 - Sandwiches / drinks for campers, bus driver
 - Volunteers during the check-in
 - Shar,
 - Systematic computerized check-in on-site
 - Bag searches - K9 search approved, SWAT team will come out and do a demo with Bearcat
 - Need tupperware bin for confiscated items with ziplocs and perm markers
 - Need tupperware bin for any meds with ziploc and perm markers - Shar will take care of both these items...
- City vehicles - must be driven by city volunteers or employees, not enough drivers for the 5 vehicles yet, not enough Explorers. Need city employees or explorers to drive up and back for insurance purposes. Crumbaker says we can put vehicles on a flatbed to transport vehicles if needed. Quinn can drive a city van up, Crumbaker will be checking on hitch on van.
- Work inside semi-trailer - have an idea for keeping items restrained on shelves, need some volunteers to complete the work. Bob will send note out when we do that.
- Bikes - have been purchased thanks to a grant from Sertoma Club. 15 bikes from Lee's Cyclery, they are being assembled now. Will have new helmets and water bottles with cages. Need to devise a system to restrain bikes in our existing bike trailer or find a new trailer that will hold 15 bikes. Quinn Lods is taking the lead on the restraint system, offer him your help if possible.
- Waste management - have 18 portolets ordered, need to send map and info to Waste Management, they will be locked and have a sign on the outside to prevent people

from using them until we arrive, they will be delivered on Friday before the Rendezvous.

- Entertainment - have scavenger hunt for Monday, Tuesday will be the K9 demo and pet show, Wednesday will be the Mountain Man, Thursday is the dance guitar stylings of CareBear and Friday will be capture the flag / MRE's with the guard (mmmmmmmm, yummmmy!)
- Horses - paid first half, second half due on July 1st. No other issues except maybe hay, will talk to Rawah Ranch / Pat Timmons, says he can take of this I will confirm with him.
- Rafts - any equipment needs? First run is this Sunday, Fathers Day. Talk to Brad McLeod if you are interested at 563-3249. Shar may have a truck and trailer to use for rafting so we don't have to use city vehicles. Brad needs more splash jackets, 9-12 bucks a piece, Brad has this.
- Biking stuff - any other equipment needs? We will have slime in all the tires, just need something to hold the bikes in place. Bike trailer needs to be checked out by Service Center.
- Hike - are we all set? Equipment needs? Run by National Guard.
- Tables for Rendezvous - Scoo working on the table issue, can use what we have if needed, can also have more made if needed but will cost \$300 + dollars. Chairs, not included in deal, will find chairs. Maybe have a work day to see what tables are in good condition. Bob will send a note out, probably do it on a Monday.
- Need detailed list of officers from FCPD who are going ASAP....

- Wanda / Rebecca may be bringing utility vans that we can use. They are bringing 1 van 8+driver
